



Sri Lanka is open to all tourists regardless of vaccination status.

At the moment, Qatar Airways and Sri Lankan Airlines operate a direct or 1 stop flights from multiple European airports to Colombo at an average price of 600 euros return in economy class.


All hotels in Sri Lanka are now categorized as :

Level1 (certified for non-vaccination quarantine Hotel) OR

Level2 (receiving vaccinated tourists and unvaccinated tourists after the end of quarantine)



For holders of a vaccination certificate with the date of the second vaccination earlier than 14 days before departure, only one negative PCR test is needed upon arrival, the result must be waited for up to a maximum of 24 hours (usually 12H) in the Kima Surf Camp Weligama inside the room or in the Kima Surf Villa on the beach of Ahangama, (by October the time should be reduced to 3 hours.)
If the test result is negative, you can freely move around the island and Stay in L2 hotels
(this is our surf camp on Weligama beach)



For those who do not have a vaccination certificate, a 14-day quarantine in a L1 category hotel and two PCR tests on days 7 and 14 are required. Our surf villa on Ahagama Beach is rated L1 and has a private beach with great waves directly opposite, so you can surf from day one, but you can only go to other spots and leave the villa after 14 days quarantine. To fly to Sri Lanka, you need to obtain an electronic tourist visa (costs \$ 35), which is issued independently on the website <https://eta.gov.lk> After confirming your booking, we will send you a code that you will need to enter in the process of filling out the visa application form.
